World's largest single dome free flight bird aviary hosting over 200 species and more than 3500 birds.

Walk on a self-guided tour through our 3-hectare aviary on our specially built boardwalks. A guidebook can be bought at reception for R20 to enhance your experience. At Birds of Eden, the slower you go the more you will get to see as our birds range from Flamingos to Weavers and all the sizes and colours in between.

Enjoy a 90min walking tour with one of our experienced rangers who will help you spot our animals. You will be able to see and photograph the animals from raised platforms located around the sanctuary. Enjoy sightings of lions, leopards, tigers, jaguars and other big cats, as well as springboks, zebras and a host of other animals. The large camps were designed and built to suit each animal's specific needs.

Direction from Cape Town:

Jukani is situated about 145Km from Mossel Bay and about 50Km from Knysna. Take the N2 heading towards Plettenberg Bay and continue past Plett remaining on the N2 for about another 10Km. Jukani is a turn to your right, same entrance as the Plett Puzzle Park. The Farmyard and Boma are both located at Jukani Wildlife Sanctuary. Monkeyland and Birds of Eden are about 150Km from Mossel Bay and 50 Km from Knysna. Take the N2 heading towards Plettenberg Bay and continue past Plett for about 16Km, remaining on the N2. Take the turn to your right at the 2nd gas station then continue to follow the signs for about 2km.

Directions from Gqeberha (Port Elizabeth):

Monkeyland and Birds of Eden are situated about 210Km from Gqeberha (Port Elizabeth). Take the N2 heading towards Cape Town and Plettenberg Bay. About 16km after the Toll Gate you will go past the sign for Natures Valley. Take the next left at the Gas station and continue to follow the signs for about another 2km.

For Jukani, remain on the N2 for a further 5km (21Km from the Toll Gate) and you will see it signposted on your left. The Farmyard and Boma are both located at Jukani Wildlife Sanctuary.
